- 1. The specified information is the following wording from para 11.9 of the peer review report:
 - 'On the Companies House website there are various companies operated by Mr. Eric Lancaster and Mr. John 'William' Lancaster'
- 2. Both individuals are named elsewhere in the report, which has been released to the world under FOIA. They both appear on the licence. We find that both individuals would have had no expectation that their names would not be disclosed. The withheld information is a factual statement describing information which is in the public domain and easily accessible by a simple search on the Companies House website. We find that there would have been no reasonable expectation of privacy in relation to this information, and no significant impact on those individuals by its disclosure.
